    - i. Rocky Mountain Oncology Center, LLC ("Company") recently underwent an indirect change of ownership ("Transaction"). The Company currently holds License No. 49-29254-01.
    - ii. By way of background, the Company is a wholly owned subsidiary of e+ healthcare, LLC ("e+"). KEPL Group LLC ("KEPL") is the sole member of e+ (i.e., in other words, KEPL is the grandparent owner of the Company). On or about June 24, 2019, in connection with the Transaction, KEPL Group, LLC ("KEPL") finalized a Stock Purchase Agreement and Plan of Merger, pursuant to which KEPL underwent a 100% change of equity ownership.
    - iii. Most notably, please be advised that following the Transaction, the direct owner of the Company (i.e., e+) remains the same, and the Company continues to operate its business in the ordinary course. To reiterate, the transaction was an indirect change of ownership, thus the Company's federal tax ID number, Legal Name, and personnel will not change.

- b. KEPL is the parent of, and controls, e+ healthcare, LLC ("e+") (owning 100% of the equity interests of e+) and all correlating e+ subsidiaries, including Rocky Mountain Oncology Center, LLC (the Licensee). Accordingly, and as noted above, as a result of the Transaction, ION (and its parent ION) will become the sole owner of KEPL. This change of ownership will occur at least three (3) levels of ownership above the Licensee and will have no direct impact of the Licensee.
- Licensee name, mailing address, and contact information, including phone numbers will not change as a result of the Transaction.
- 2. Describe any changes in personnel or duties that relate to the licensed program. Include training and experience for new personnel and any changes in the training program.
  - a. There will be no changes in the Radiation Safety Officer, Authorized Users, other personnel, or duties that relate to the licensed program. Further, there will be no changes in the training program.
- 3. Describe any changes in the location, facilities, equipment, radiation safety program, use, possession, waste management, or other procedures that relate to the licensed program.
  - a. All business will be conducted in accordance with the commitments previously submitted by the Licensee. There will be no changes in the Licensee's location, equipment, radiation safety program, use, possession, or waste management related to the licensed program.
- 4. Describe the status of the licensee's facilities, equipment, and radiation safety program, including any known contamination and whether decontamination will occur prior to transfer. Include the status of calibrations, leak tests, area surveys, wipe tests, training, quality control, and related records.
  - a. The current status of the Licensee's location includes no known areas of contamination.

    All calibrations, leak tests, area surveys, wipe tests, training, quality control, and records remain current.
- 5. If current decommissioning funding plans (DFP) will be changed as a result of the transfer, the revised DFP should be submitted. If other financial assurance documents will be changed as a result of the transfer, confirm that all financial assurance instruments associated with the license will be held in the transferee's name before the license is transferred, and as required by 10 CFR 30.35(f), the licensee must, within 30 days, submit financial instruments reflecting such changes.
  - a. There is no plan to decommission the Licensee's facility at this time. Further, there will be no change in financial assurance requirement related to the Licensee.
- Confirm that all records concerning the safe and effective decommissioning of the facility will be transferred to the transferee or to NRC, as appropriate. These records include documentation of surveys of ambient radiation levels and fixed and/or removable contamination, including methods and sensitivity.
  - a. We reiterate that the Transaction will not result in any change in the Licensee, including its record retention practices and policies. Therefore, all records concerning the safe and effective decommission of the facility will remain held by the Licensee.

- 7. Confirm that both transferor and transferee agree to transferring control of the licensed material and activity, and the conditions of transfer, and that the transferee has been made aware of any open inspection items and its responsibility for possible resulting enforcement actions.
  - a. The undersigned confirm the foregoing on behalf of themselves and the Licensee.
- 8. Confirm that the transferee will abide by all constraints, conditions, requirements, representations, and commitments of the transferor or that the transferee will submit a complete description of the proposed licensed program.
  - a. ION will abide by all constraints, conditions, requirements, representations, and commitments of the Licensee.
- 9. The transferee, in the case of fuel cycle facilities, shall provide documentation showing that it is financially qualified to conduct normal operations. The information can be in the form of income statements and balance sheet forecasts.
  - Not applicable; this is not a fuel cycle facility.



  - b. If you decide not to acquire or possess and use authorized material; or
  - When no principal activities under the license have been conducted for a period of 24 months.
- In accordance with 10 CFR 35.14, notify the NRC no later than 30 days after:
  - The date that the licensee permits an individual to work as an authorized user, an authorized nuclear pharmacist or an authorized medical physicist under 10 CFR 35.13(b)(1) through (b)(4);
  - An authorized user, an authorized nuclear pharmacist, a Radiation Safety Officer, or an authorized medical physicist permanently discontinues duties under the license or has a name change;
  - c. The licensee's mailing address changes:
  - The licensee's name changes, but the name change does not constitute a transfer of control of the license as described in 10 CFR 30.34(b); or
  - e. The licensee has added to or changed the areas of use identified in the application or on the license where byproduct material is used in accordance with either 35.100 or 35.200.
- 5. Request and obtain a license amendment before you:
  - a. Change Radiation Safety Officers;
  - b. Order byproduct material in excess of the amount, radionuclide or form authorized on the license;

6. Submit a complete renewal application or termination request at least 30 days before the expiration date on your license. You will receive a reminder notice approximately 90 days before the expiration date. Possession of radioactive material after your license expires is a violation of NRC regulations.

NRC will periodically inspect your radiation safety program. Failure to conduct your program according to NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC may result in enforcement action against you. This could include issuance of a notice of violation; imposition of a civil penalty; or an order suspending, modifying, or revoking your license as specified in the NRC Enforcement Policy.
