
ORDER PERMITTING PARTICIPATION BY THE  
STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA

On August 10, 1967, the State of South Carolina, acting by and through its Assistant Attorney General, filed a petition to intervene in this proceeding as its interest might appear in accordance with the provisions of the Atomic Energy Commission's Regulations, 10 CFR Part 2, Section 2.715(c). That Section provides that an interested State which is not a party to the proceeding will be afforded a reasonable opportunity to participate in the proceeding and to introduce evidence, interrogate witnesses and to advise the Atomic Energy Commission without requiring the State to take a position with respect to the issues.

WHEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, pursuant to the Atomic Energy Act, as amended, the Commission's Rules of Practice, particularly Section 2.715(c), that the request is granted and the State of South Carolina is permitted to participate in the proceeding in accordance with Section 2.715(c) of the Commission's Rules.
