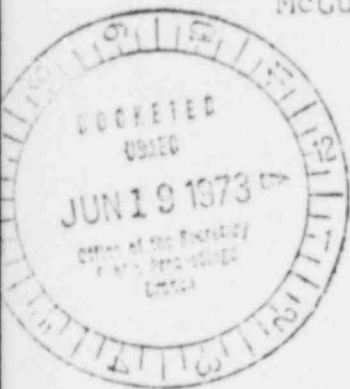

Affidavit of Stanley Ragone

Leckie, Esquire, Antitrust Division, United States Department of Justice, to John H. Shenefield, Counsel for Virginia Electric and Power Company.

(3) In compliance with the requests for documents in the subpoena, as modified, I made reasonable inquiry of those officers and employees of Virginia Electric and Power Company

Taylor, Manager of Power Supply, R. S. Gay, Manager of Rates, and G. J. Porter, Senior Staff Engineer, Power Supply.


(4) In the resulting document search, no documents have been identified that fall within the scope of the subpoena duces tecum.
