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REACTOR BUILDING LEAK-RATE SPECIFICATIONS FOR OCONEE (DOCKET NOS. 50-269, 50-270, and 50-287)

The proposed tech specs for reactor building leak-rate (Paragraph 15.4.3 of POL, Volume II) have been reviewed. Several deficiencies have been noted; the details are the enclosure. The deficiencies include:

- Leak rate is not well defined, as it is specified at one pressure only. No mention is made of acceptance values at a reduced test pressure.
- 2. Leak rate may be permitted to approach 3%/day, provided it is through the penetration room. However the analysis ignores the increased release of non-filterables (including organic iodine as well as noble gases). In addition the charcoal heat load calculation is not presented.
- 3. No specific test criteria are presented for the 40 year life of the plant. Instead it is proposed to await the results of the first refueling-outage tests on each nuclear unit.
- 4. It appears that Duke proposes that a re-test on one unit is applicable to the other two.
- No individual penetration leak-rate limits are presented.
 No corrective action, such as plantshutdown, is offered.

We should explore these points with Duke at the next technical meeting.
