Gentlemen:

This refers to the inspection conducted by Mr. F. Jape of this office on April 9-12, 1974, of activities authorized by AEC Operating License No. DPR-47 for the Oconee 2 facility, and to the discussion of our findings held by Mr. F. Jape with Mr. J. W. Hampton at the conclusion of the inspection.

Areas examined during the inspection and our findings are discussed in the enclosed inspection report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examination of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector.

Within the scope of this inspection, no violations were disclosed.

Three new unresolved items resulted from this inspection and are identified in Section III of the summary of the enclosed report. These items will be examined during subsequent inspections.

In accordance with Section 2.790 of the AEC's "Rules of Practice," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, a copy of this letter and the enclosed inspection report will be placed in the AEC's Public Document Room. If this report contains any information that you believe to be proprietary, it is necessary that you submit a written application to this office requesting that such information be withheld from public disclosure. If no proprietary information is identified, a written statement to that effect should be submitted. If an application is

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
