NOTICE OF ISSUANCE OF MEDIANT TO FACILITY OF BRATING LICENSE

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (the Commission) has issued Amendment No. 11 to the Facility Operating License No. NPF-3, issued to the Toledo Edison Company and the Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company, for operation of the Davis-Besse Nuclear Power Station, Unit No. 1 (the facility) located in Ottawa County, Chio. The amendment is effective as of the date of its issuance.

This amendment revises the Technical Specifications to reflect plant operation at full-rated power (2772 Megawatts-thermal) with the purnable poison rod assemblies and and orifice rod assemblies (except two) removed from the core.

Also, this amendment deletes license condition 2.C.(3)(1) from the operating license No. NPF-3 which specified the penalties for the effects of fuel rod bowing on the departure from nucleate boiling.

The amendment also revises a technical specification regarding a change in the alarm setpoints on quadrant tilt.

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The application for the amendment complies with the standards and requirements of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended (the Act), and the Commission's rules and regulations. The Commission has made appropriate findings as required by the Act and the Commission's rules and regulations in 10 CFR Chapter I, which are set forth in the license amendment.

The Commission has determined that the granting of this relief will not result in any significant environmental impact and that pursuant to 10 CFR §51.5(d)(4) an environmental impact statement or negative declaration and environmental impact appraisal need not be prepared in connection with this action.
