Dear Mr. Moseley:

We offer the following response to the deficiency noted in the referenced Inspection Report.

NOTICE OF VIOLATION

- 1. The licensee's approved retraining program specifies a retraining frequency of two years while the respiratory protection program specified an annual retraining frequency for respiratory protection training. Also, the retraining program does not include the periodic training in respiratory protection for licensed operators although the respiratory protection program requires annual retraining of all individuals in the program.
- Respirators were not packaged or stored in accordance with the requirements of the respiratory protection program procedures in that respirators were not individually bagged to maintain cleanliness or stored in a manner to prevent damage or taking a set.
- A revision has been submitted for the retraining procedure to indicate a one year training frequency for all personnel included in the respiratory protection program. Licensed operators have been included in this new schedule. It should be noted that no individual has gone beyond the prescribed annual retraining requirement.
- Respirators have been packaged and stored in accordance with the requirements of the respiratory protection program. Each respirator was cleaned, individually bagged, and stored in a manner to prevent damage.

In an effort to avoid further noncompliance, the Notice of Violation was discussed with members of the Chemistry and Radiation staff, with instructions to more closely monitor the status of equipment on monthly inspections.

As of this date full compliance with the above has been achieved.
