NOTICE OF ISSUANCE OF PROVISIONAL CONSTRUCTION PERMIT

DO NOT REMOVE

Notice is hereby given that, pursuant to the Initial Decision of the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board, dated September 24, 1968, the Director of the Division of Reactor Licensing has issued Provisional Construction Permit No. CPPR-51 to the Florida Power Corporation for the construction of a pressurized water nuclear reactor, designated as Crystal River Unit 3 Nuclear Generating Plant, on the applicant's site on the Gulf of Mexico, about seven and one-half miles northwest of the town of Crystal River, Citrus County, Florida. The reactor is designed for initial operation at approximately 2452 megawatts (thermal).
