In accordance with the understandings which were reflected in Secretary Udall's letter of March 20, 1964 to Chairman Seabory. I am forwarding herewith Volumes 1, 2, 3, and 4 of the Preliminary Safety Analysis Report filed by Florida Power Corporation for the proposed construction and operation of two pressurized water nuclear reactors at its site on the Gulf of Mexico, 70 miles north of Tampa and about 7-1/2 miles northwest of Crystal River, Citrus County, Florida. The proposed reactors are each designed for operation at 2544 megawatts thermal with a net electrical output of approximately megawatts.

We would appreciate receiving a report from the Bureau of Sport Fisheries and Wildlife concerning those features of the proposed reactor operation which might have radiological effects on fish and shellfish.

On the basis of our tentative schedule for this project, it would be desirable to have your report available for our use by November 1, 1967.
