A copy of the Florida Power Corp. Training Program for Crystal River Unit #3 was provided by Mr. Hancock. A review of the document indicates that it is comprehensive and appears to provide a basis for achieving a satisfactory operating and engineering staff prior to completion of construction of Unit #3.

The cold licensing requirements of operators was discussed and it was noted by J. Buzy that certification for exem would require resident time at a comparable PWR of 4½ months.

Mr. Hancock noted that training has already been initiated and that a 26 week introductory course in nuclear engineering is in progress. In addition, preliminary courses are sponsored by use of adult education progrem in math and chemistry.

The shift staff, proposed by FPC will consist of 6 men per shift assigned a 5 shift schedule.
