Your recent letter to the President has been referred to the Atomic Energy Commission for reply.

The power plant site you described appears to be the site of Florida Power Corporation's Crystal River Plant. Units 1 and 2 of this plant are operating and are fired by fossil fuel. Unit 3 is a nuclear fueled plant and is just being built at this time. The three booklets I am enclosing describe nuclear plants such as the Crystal River Unit 3 and our procedures for licensing and regulating them. I am also enclosing a copy of the Florida Power Corporation's environmental report concerning Undt 3.
