Five Additional TMI-2 Related Requirements

to Operating Reactors

Dear Sir:

Darrell G. Eisenhut requested all operating reactor licensees to reply within 30 days of receipt of the May 7, 1980, letter on five additional TMI-2 related requirements. Florida Power Corporation will attempt to meet the commitment items in an expeditious manner.

Florida Power Corporation has not received Item 1 of your May 7, 1980 letter "I.A.1.3 - Shift Manning" yet. Most of the remaining requests require a considerable technical review in order to understand the implications and effects on safety items. Other requests require the development of new systems which may not be commercially available. The B&W Owners Group is meeting during the later part of June to discuss what has to be done to accomplish these requests and the time frame required. After this meeting, we will further develop our internal plans.

Florida Power Corporation requests an extension to July 21, 1980 to commit to these requirements and schedule their implementation.
