The Commission has elected not to review ALAB-590 on its own initiative. The Commission's determination not to review the Atomic Safety and Licensing Appeal Board decision does not constitute a departure from the standard for determining whether a prospective intervenor has set forth an acceptable contention as articulated in <u>Mississippi Power and Light Co.</u> (Grand Gulf Nuclear Station, Units 1 and 2), ALAB-130, 6 AEC 423 (1973). Chairman Ahearne dissents and would summarily reverse ALAB-590.
