Dear Mr. Cunningham:

This letter is an addendum to our letter of May 15, 1980 requesting a hearing on your order of May 7, 1980. As such we would like you to consider the following as an addition to, and in no way a replacement of that letter.

Prior to the hearing we request, pursuant to the "Freedom of Information Act":

1. The cost benefit analysis of your order of May 7, 1980
2. The list of the incidents listed in the first paragraph of section I of your order including
 - a. the estimated excess exposures received by both patients and radiation therapy personnel.
 - b. the way in which the indicated malfunction was detected.

In addition to the five point of question in our letter of May 15, 1980, we also question:

- vi the potential for lethal exposures of operating personnel. Incidents of which we are aware in recent years have lead to exposures less than or about 0.1 rem. low by $3\frac{1}{2}$ orders of magnitude for lethal exposures.
