The Commission has issued the enclosed Amendment No. 14 to Facility Operating License No. IPF-3 for the Davis-Besse Nuclear Power Station. Unit No. 1, in response to your submittal dated June 5, 1978, as revised September 20, 1973, November 10, 1978, December 26, 1973, January 12, 1979, February 22, 1979, and March 16, 1979.

The amendment modifies the license to include the current Commissionapproved physical security plan. This has been discussed with and agreed to by your staff.

We have completed our review and evaluation of your physical security plan as revised, and have concluded that the physical security plan for your facility, when fully implemented, wil' provide the protection needed to meet the general performance requirements of 10 CFR 73.55(a) and the objectives of the specific requirements of 10 CFR 73.55, paragraphs (b) through (h), without impairing your ability to safely operate your facility. We therefore further conclude that the plan as revised is acceptable.

The enclosed Security Plan Evaluation Report (SPER) represents our evaluation and acceptance of your physical security plan as revised. The SPER is being withheld from public disclosure pursuant to 10 CFR 2.790(d).

see seam Changes which would not decrease the effectiveness of your approved Flan security plan may be made without approval by the Commission pursuant to the authority of 10 CFR 50.54(p). A report containing a description of each change shall be furnished to the Director, Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation, U. S. Muclear Regulatory Commission, Washington, D. C. 20555, with a copy to the appropriate MRC Regional Office within two

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
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months after the change is made. Records of changes made without Commission approval shall be maintained for a period of two years from the date of the change.

We have evaluated the potential for environmental impact of plant operation in accordance with the enclosed amendment. We have determined that the amendment does not authorize a change in effluent types or total amounts nor an increase in power level, and will not result in any significant environmental impact. Having made this determination, we have further concluded that the amendment involves an action which is insignificant from the standpoint of environmental impact and pursuant to 10 CFR \$51.5(d)(4) that an environmental impact statement or negative declaration and environmental impact appraisal need not be prepared in connection with the issuance of this amendment.

The amendment does not involve significant new safety information of a type not considered by a previous Commission safety review of the facility. It does not involve a significant increase in the probability or consequences of an accident, does not involve a significant decrease in a safety margin, and therefore does not involve a significant hazards consideration. We have also concluded that there is reasonable assurance that the health and safety of the public will not be endangered by this action.
