
Completion of Depositions (and all Discovery)	July 1, 1975
Prehearing Conference No. 5 (to consider all pretrial matters and motions)	September 1, 1975
Filing of Direct Written Expert Testimony By All Parties	September 15, 1975
Filing of Pretrial Briefs	October 1, 1975
Evidentiary Hearing Commences	October 6, 1975

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Staff also proposes that the Board grant motions for Extensions of Time only upon showing of good cause when said motion is made in strict compliance with the Commission's Rules of Practice.

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
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
