As a matter of possible interest to you, I am enclosing a copy of a notice relating to an application filed by The Toledo Edison Company and The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company for a construction purmit and facility license to authorize construction and operation of a pressurized water nuclear reactor on the applicants' site on the southwest shore of Lake Erie, approximately twenty-one miles east of Toledo, in Ottawa County, Ohio.

The proposed reactor, designated as the Davis-Besse Nuclear Power Station, is designed for initial operation at approximately 2633 megawatts thermal with a net electrical output of approximately 872 megawatts. Earliest and latest construction completion dates are estimated by the applicants to be April 1, 1974 and April 1, 1975, respectively.

Copies of this letter, with enclosure, are being sent to the Michigan Department of Public Health, the Michigan Department of Commerce, the Department of Conservation, the Michigan Department of Labor, the State of Michigan Public Service Commission, and the University of Michigan Law School for their information.
