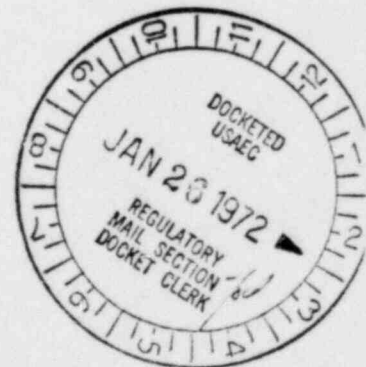
WHEREFORE, Applicant requests the licenses specified in its original Application.
