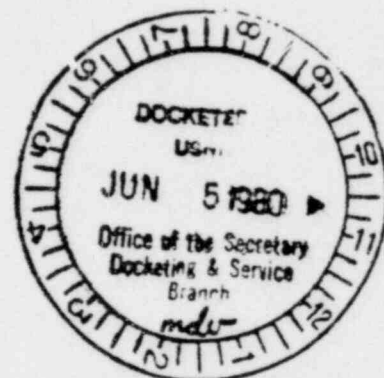

SUBJECT: PETITION FOR RULEMAKING UNDER
10CFR2.802: MODIFICATION TO
10CFR19.13(e)



Dear Sir:

The addition of paragraph (e) to 10CFR19.13 greatly strengthened the ability of employers of transient workers to obtain records for their employees; however, there is additional information necessary in order to have an accurate and up-to-date exposure history for an employee. The employee or designee who is sent a written estimate of the dose needs a follow up report of the actual dose as soon as the report is available.

I suggest adding the following sentence to 10CFR19(e):

"When a written estimate is provided to the worker or his designee, it shall be followed by a written report of the actual exposure within thirty days of the availability of personnel monitoring reports."
