SUBJECT: IMPLEMENTATION OF TMI ACTION PLAN ITEMS

We are preparing letters to OL applicants, CP holders, and licensees that will summarize the requirements that are contained in NUREG-0660.

For OL applicants and CP holders we plan to use the listing of requirements as presented in Enclosure 1 of SECY 80-230. With regard to Part 5 of Enclosure 1, "Proposed Dated Requirements", it is our view that none of these are of such significance as to require prior public comment. All but two of these requirements have already been transmitted to licensees (by letter May 7, 1980); the remaining two (I.A.3.1 and I.C.6) are minor requirements. The requirement of I.A.3.1 is part of a revision now being prepared to §55.23 and could be considered a candidate for deferral until the rule change is in place. However, in a recent staff paper, NRR told the Commission that we were planning to implement this requirement right away.

For operating reactor licensees, the list of requirements is almost the same as for OL applicants. However, since the list of OL prerequisites in Enclosure 1 to SECY 80-230 was limited to those Action Plan items with implementation dates up to January 1, 1981, there are a number of other requirements (i.e., those with implementation dates beyond January 1, 1981) which have now been approved by the Commission and for which we must decide on our implementation policy. These items, specifically, are those Decision Group B items listed in part b. of Enclosure 2 to SECY 80-230 that were not included in Enclosure 1. They are as follows:

- I.A.2.2 Training and Qualifications of Operating Personnel
- I.A.2.5 Plant Drills
- I.A.4.1 Initial Simulator Improvement
- I.D.1 Control Room Upgrade
- I.D.2 Safety Parameter Display
- II.E.4.4 Purging
- II.E.5.1 Design Evaluation - B&W
- II.E.5.2 B&W Reactor Transient Response Task Force
- II.F.3 Reg. Guide 1.97

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
