Gentlemen:

Enclosed are three (3) signed originals and thirty-seven (37) copies of a revision to the proposed technical specifications for NPSH modifications to the Low Head Safety Injection and Recirculation Spray Pumps.

The purpose of this revision is to provide the flow and pressure acceptance criteria for the Quench Spray Pumps surveillance.

Safety Evaluation

This change provides the assurance that the Quench Spray Subsystem will perform its intended safety function by periodically testing the system. The test criteria are established so that an adequate flow and sufficient discharge pressure are developed to ensure pump operability.
