CHAIRMAN AHEARNE: This is an Affirmation Session on the Order of the Tarapur Export. I would like to vote to hold on less than one week's notice. All in favor?

CHAIRMAN AHEARNE: Sam?

MR. CHILK: The Commission has before it a memorandum and order in the matter of Edlow International Company, an agent for the Government of India, on applications for export of special nuclear materials and components.

The Commission, by a unanimous vote cannot find, based on a reasonable judgment of the assurances provided by the Government India and other information available, that license applications identified as XSNM01379 and 1569, XCOM0240, 0250, 0376, 0381 and 0395 meet the criteria for issuance set forth in Sections 109, 127, and 128 of the Atomic Energy Act.

Accordingly, NRC is referring these applications to the President pursuant to the procedures set forth in Section 126(b)(2) of the Atomic Energy Act.

Mr. Kennedy, who is not present today, joins in the unanimous vote of the Commission. The order will also have attached to it the separate views of Chairman Ahearne, Commissioner Gilinsky, Commissioner Kennedy, Commissioner Hendrie, with Commissioner Bradford basically agreeing with Commissioner Gilinsky's comments.
