Dear Sir:

A siren system is being proposed for notification of the public in the event of an accident at the Trojan Nuclear Plant. A design description of the siren system was submitted for review to Region X of the Federal Emergency Management Agency office on June 20, 1980.

In February 1980 you agreed in a discussion with Mr. T. D. Walt to review the proposed design; therefore, attached for your review is a draft Appendix 1-B to the Trojan Radiological Emergency Plan and Procedures Manual entitled "Description of Public Notification System for the Trojan Nuclear Plant".

We would appreciate your addressing the following questions in regard to this document:

1. Do sirens constitute an adequate public notification system?
2. Does the proposed system comply with Criterion E.6 and Appendix 3 of the draft NUREG-0654/FEMA-REP-1?

If either the final revision to 10 CFR 50 or the finalized version of NUREG-0654 include changes in the notification system design criteria, the notification system design may be modified accordingly.


