Pertinent to the Draft Regulatory Guide Task OH902-1, I offer these comments:

- 1. Mention co p. 1 of Genetic Effects is foolish, since data on a large sample from HIROSHIMA is now available, and show no evidence whatsoever for such effects. Delete this part, since the fear is unjustified, and serves no useful purpose.
- 2. The instructions concerning risk seem ridiculous in light of the total ignorance of medical exposures, given during routine recovery X-ray examinations, or in other radiative treatments. Surgical recoveries are frequently accompanied by regular X-ray procedures, exposing the patient to more than 1000 mrem over a weeks! time. The patients are rarely, if ever, advised of the risks from such exposure.
