This refers to an unannounced inspection conducted by C. C. Peck of our Region III office on January 7-18, 1980. A shipment of radioactive waste shipped from your facility was inspected upon arrival at the Nuclear Engineering Company, Richland, Washington disposal site.


Areas examined during the inspection and our findings are discussed in the enclosed inspection report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of a review of the shipping papers, placarding and labeling requirements, radiation measurements, selective contamination surveys, and observations by the inspector.

Within the scope of this inspection, no items of noncompliance were disclosed.

In accordance with Section 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, a copy of this letter and the enclosed inspection report will be placed in the NRC's Public Document Room. If we do not hear from you in this regard within the specified period, the report will be placed in the Public Document Room.
