This letter is in response to your request for additional information to our "Supplement to Environmental Report - Subsurface Tailings Disposal".

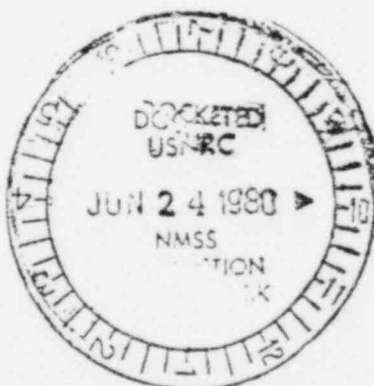
