Dear Mr. Reid:

Your letter of April II, 1980 requested the District to submit a revised Technical Specifications based on the Fire Protection Standard Technical Specifications.

In your Fire Protection Safety Evaluation Report (SER) dated February 28, 1978, you provided a schedule for completion of all required modifications at the Rancho Seco Nuclear Generating Station. All modifications were required to be completed by the end of the 1979 refueling outage, which did not commence until early 1980 due to outages which occurred in 1979. The SER also identified many areas where you needed further information to fully evaluate our facility's fire protection capability, and we have subsequently provided you with that information. Based on our submittals, acceptable. Therefore, it is now appropriate for us to revise our Technical Specifications to conform to the Standard as requested by you.

In accordance with 10 CFR 50.59, the Sacramento Municipal Utility District proposes to amend its operating license DPR-54 for Rancho Seco Nuclear Generating Station No. 1, by submitting Proposed Amendment No. 68, on June 19, 1980. Today, we are submitting forty (40) copies of Proposed Amendment No. 68, which incorporates the pertinent and applicable changes suggested and required by your staff. This submittal is exempt from the requested Class Lil fee under the provision of Footnote 2 to 10 CFR 170.22. Footnote 2 does permit the exemption of certain types of license amendments from fees. These are:

1. Those in fee Classes I, II and III which result from written Commission request provided that they have only minor safety significance, are to simplify or clarify the license or Technical Specifications and are being issued for the convenience of the Commission, and

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2. Orders issued by the Commission pursuant to 10 CFR 2.204.

The Commission requested this revision via a letter from Robert Reid (NRC) to J. J. Mattimoe dated April 11, 1980.
