Commissioners Bradford, Gilinsky, Kennedy, Hendrie and Chairman Aherne.
Sirs:

Please Consider this letter my petition under 10CFR 2.714 to object to the Memo and Order of 6-12-80 in Docket 50-320. I presume that others will be objecting to many matters and I shall attempt not to object to matters objected to by others. These matters which I am not dealing with in this objection but which are nonetheless abhorrent to due process and due regard for human life include

1. The Staff documentation on venting is limited to the things which the Staff feels require looking at. It is not definitive. It is not comprehensive.
2. The NRC waives its own rules for no good reason. There is no 30 day comment period prior to the action. There are no public hearings prior to the order.
3. The points brought up by the Heidelberg Institute group have not been answered by the NRC nor have they been considered inconsequential by any authority to date.
4. The Corporation which will be in full charge and control of this venting has shown that it is unable to even open a door. The attempt by Metropolitan Edison to open a containment door earlier this month shows how very inept this Corporation still is. Obviously, Met Ed is still as inept at handling a nuclear reactor as it was ~~six~~ on March 28, 1979. An inept corporation must not handle a dangerous venting where danger to human beings is imminent.

However, my particular objection is this:

The NRC is acting like a dictator. The NRC is trading human lives for corporate profit. The NRC is suspending its own rules and its own promises to promote the viability of a corporation.

The NRC is equating the viability of a corporation to the value of endangering human lives.
