Please Consider this letter my petition under 10CFR 2.714 to object to the Memo and Order of 6-12-80 in Docket 50-320.

Hower, my particular objection is this:

The NRC is acting like a dictator. The NRC is trading humen lives and to be for corporate profit. The NRC is suspending its own rules and to be its own promises to promote the viability of a corporation.

The NRC is equating the viability of a corporation to the value of endangering human lives.
