A routine Safeguards inspection was made of your activities authorized by NRC License XSNM-1426 at the Port of Oakland, Oakland, California, on June 10, 1980.

The inspection was conducted by Region V safeguards inspectors A. Wieder and S. Rowinski, and Radiation Specialists B. Riedlinger and F. Fong. There were no items of noncompliance found.


