Attached for your review are two (2) reports which address the LaSalle County containment load definition. These reports were discussed with Mr. C. Anderson of the NRC Staff at the Mark II Owners Group meeting on June 12, 1980, and should be forwarded to Mr. Anderson for his continuing review. Specifically, the reports address the following topics:

"Condensation Oscillation (CO) Load Data for LaSalle" 1.

"Chugging Loads for Assessment of 4T CO Data" 2.

These reports incorporate the Mark II Lead Plant approach for assessing the main vent steam condensation loads observed during the most recent Mark II testing at the General Electric 4T test facility. This recent testing is referred to as the 4T Condensation Oscillation (4T CO) test and includes both Condensation Oscillation and Chugging data. In addition to describing the Mark II Lead Plant approach, these reports include the application of this approach to develop specific loads for assessment of LaSalle County Station.

To expediate submittal of these reports, they presently are being submitted only on the LaSalle County Station Docket. After appropriate review, it is anticipated the other Lead Plant Owners will submit similar documents or reference these LaSalle County Station reports.

For LaSalle County Station, currently one (1) original and three (3) signed copies of these reports are submitted, and copies are being sent directly to the NRC Mark II Containment consultants.
