Thile replacing the nonqualified splices connecting the safety-relief valves colonoide' pictails to the nuclear grade cable, addressed in LER 2-80-46, it was discovered that the pigtails on the solenoids were brittle and that the inculation would crack when handled. Target-Rock was contacted about this problem and they stated that the solenoids in use at Brunswick Steam Electric Float (BSEF) were not qualified. They provided information to BSEP which allowed us to locate and procure qualified solenoids for the safety-relief valves. These qualified solenoids, slong with the qualified splices, will be installed on each unit before startup.
