I have recently received a copy of the Tennessee Valley Authority letter dated June 13, 1980, concerning the Edgemont Uranium Mill Decommissioning Plant Environmental Report.

It is noted that Dose standards are not being met and that at times the doses to residents in the vicinity of the Edgemont Uranium Mill are not expected to be in compliance with these standards.

As president of the Midwest Environmental Protective Associates, we object to any variance from standards. We object to any variance of these standards because the health of people are involved and we object because we are surprised that a Governmental Agency such as TVA would ask for a variance.
