

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Response to Noncompliance Item No. 10 of Appendix A

The Responsible Investigator in charge of the source material has been advised that the material cannot be used until it has been wipe tested. The Radiation Safety Officer must be notified well in advance of intended use so that arrangements for leak testing can be made. Full compliance was achieved for this item June 23, 1980.

To avoid further noncompliance we are requesting an amendment to license number SUD-197 which would delete the condition of wipe testing our source material. Attached is a letter to the NRC Material Licensing Branch which requests the amendment to this license. Upon receipt of the amendment we will resume use of the source material under conditions specified in the license and amendment.
