Millstone Nuclear Power Station, Unit Nos. 1 and 2 Proposed Revisions to Technical Specifications

Pursuant to 10CFR50.90, Northeast Nuclear Energy Company (NNECO) hereby proposes to amend its operating licenses, DPR-21 and DPR-65, by incorporating the changes identified in Attachment 1 into the Millstone Unit No. 1 Technical Specifications and the changes identified in Attachment 2 into the Millstone Unit No. 2 Technical Specifications.

The proposed changes in Attachments 1 and 2 reflect recent organizational title changes and the Technical Specifications are proposed to be clarified accordingly.

The above proposed changes have been reviewed pursuant to 10CFR50.59 and have not been found to constitute an unreviewed safety question. The basis for this determination is that these changes only reflect organizational title changes with no change in responsibility within NNECO.

The Millstone Site Nuclear Review Board has reviewed and approved the aboveproposed changes and concurred in the above determination.

NNECO has reviewed the proposed license amendment and has determined that this proposed Technical Specification change constitutes a Class II license amendment for Millstone Unit No. 2 and a Class I license amendment for Millstone Unit No. 1 as it is a duplicate amendment for a second unit at the same site. In addition, NNECO has determined that the proposed

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license amendment for Millstone Unit No. 2 can be incorporated into the Cycle 4 reload effort for which the appropriate license amendment fee for a Class IV change has been forwarded in Reference (1). Therefore, please find enclosed the Class I license amendment fee of \$400 (Four Hundred Dollars).
