This letter is to confirm the conversation between Mr. R. W. Samuel, Unit II Plant Operations Review Committee Vice Chairman, and Mr. R. J. Conta, Senior Resident Inspector, Three Mile Island, Unit II Program Office at 1912 hours on July 17, 1980. Mr. R. J. Conta (Region I Designee) agreed to inform the Region I Director of this conversation.

A condition considered reportable under Technical Specification 6.9.1.3.b will be entered at 0230 hours on July 17, 1980.

On July 14, 1980 the Gray B&P diesel generator failed to start while performing Surveillance Procedure 4303-M16. The follow-up investigation indicated a possible problem with the 100 RPM speed switch. This speed switch disables the air start system when 100 RPM is reached at the generator. It also activates the governor shutdown solenoid after 5 seconds if the event the diesel has failed to reach 100 RPM. During a start attempt, while troubleshooting, two of four air-start motors failed to engage properly and the diesel was manually tripped. Due to this failure the diesel could not be returned to service within the 72 hours required by action statement (a) for Technical Specification 6.3.1.1, hence a prompt report is submitted.

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The diesel generator will be returned to operable status as soon as replacement parts are received and installed, and control circuit problems are rectified.
