NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Based on the results of an NRC inspection conducted on April 24, 1980, it appears that certain of your activities were not conducted in full compliance with NRC regulations as indicated below:

Condition 17 of your license requires that licensed material be possessed and used in accordance with the statements, representations, and procedures contained in your application dated May 9, 1978.

1. Item 15 of your application requires that personnel monitor their hands for contamination after each procedure or before leaving the area.

Contrary to this requirement, on the day of inspection, April 24, 1980, individuals working in your hot lab area failed to monitor their hands after each procedure. These individuals were noted to have easily detectable levels of radioactive contamination on their hands.

2. Item 15 of this same application requires that you survey areas used for the elution of Mo-99/Tc-99m generators, for the preparation of radiopharmaceuticals from reagent kits, and for preparation of individual patient doses, for contamination after each procedure and/or at the end of each working day.

Contrary to this requirement, as of the day of the inspection, April 24, 1980 you have failed to survey your preparation areas daily.

These are infractions.

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
