

He have received your letter, dated December 11, 1978, to the Secretary of the Buclear Regulatory Commission regarding application of NRC Staff Policy on Open Meetings to meetings held on the Shoreham review. Since the policy in question is one applied by the KRC Staff as distinguished from the Commission itself, your letter has been directed to me for a response.

2s it is stated in the Pederal Pegister of June 28, 1978, the Open Heeting Policy is a formal articulation of the general practice that has been followed by the Staff in the past. In accordance with this practice, meetings that were held to exchange technical information and views necessary for the technical review of applications have been noticed and summarized by the MRC Staff. For those Shoreham meetings that have been held to facilitate this technical exchange of information between the Long Island Lighting Company (LILCO) and the MRC Staff, goo have been sent the appropriate notices and summaries.

In addition to the technical seetings, other meetings have been held between representatives of LILCO and ERC management that were not noticed. You and other parties to the Shorehar proceeding were informed of these meetings by a letter from NRC Staff Counsel dated January 3, 1979. These meetings were held to discuss the status of the Shoreham licensing review and scheduling of applicant input data and Staff review activities for the various staff branches involved in the review of the Storeham facility. Since these meetings did not involve the exchange of technical information, or any other information which would affect the result of our review, summaries have not been prepared.

In my view, holding such non-substantive siteduling type meetings with a license applicant without providing notice to other parties or interested persons is not inconsistent with the policy statement. Econorer, for the Shoreham case, such meetings are no longer needed
