Thank you for your letter of inquiry regarding events at the Three Mile Island Nuclear Power Station. I regret that this answer to your letter has been delayed. The accident and its consequences have created a substantial increase in the agency's workload, which has prevented us from responding to you as promptly as we would have liked to.
