On November 1 at approximately 10:00 a.m., an employee was observed by management personnel acting in an "irregular manner". Upon the advice of the plant medical department, the individual was transported to the city hospital by the County Sheriff's Department. While enroute, the individual stated, "The assembly area is going to blow up".

The plant was notified and a search of the assembly area and the individual's car was conducted by the licensee with the assistance of the Sheriff's Department. The results were negative.

Total media interest is anticipated. A news release is not planned by the licensee nor the NRC. The State of North Carolina has been informed.

The IAT was notified.

This Preliminary Notification is issued for information only and no further IE action is anticipated.
