## Gentlemen:

This refers to the inspection conducted by Mr. F. Jape of this office on November 27-30, 1973, and December 3-7, 1973, of activities authorized by AEC Operating License No. DPR-47 for the Oconee 2 facility, and to the discussion of our findings held by Mr. F. Jape with Messrs. J. E. Smith and J. W. Hampton at the conclusion of the inspection.

Areas examined during the inspection and our findings are discussed in the enclosed inspection report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examination of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector.

The results of our inspection of your corrective action on previously identified violations are discussed in Section II of the summary of the enclosed report.

The status of unresolved items identified in previous inspection reports is discussed in Section IV of the summary of the enclosed report.

During the inspection it was found that certain activities under your license appear to be in violation of AEC requirements. The violations and references to pertinent requirements are listed in Section I of the summary of the enclosed report.

No response is required for violations listed under I. A. 1. a., b.(1) and c, since these matters were resolved and corrective actions verified during the inspection.

Your response to Item I. A. 2 has been requested in our notice of violation letter, 50-269/73-13, sent to you on December 26, 1973. No additional response is requested by this letter.

With regard to violations listed under I. A. 1. b.(2), b.(3) and d., Section 2.201 of the AEC's "Rules of Practice," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, requires that you submit within 20 days, in writing, your comments concerning these items, a description of any steps that have been or will be taken to correct these items, a description of any steps that have been or will be taken to prevent recurrence, and the date the corrective actions or preventive measure were or will be completed.

In accordance with Section 2.790 of the AEC's "Rules of Practice," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, a copy of this letter and the enclosed inspection report will be placed in the AEC's Public Document Room. If this report contains any information that you believe to be proprietary, it is necessary that you submit a written application to this office requesting that such information be withheld from public disclosure. If no proprietary information is identified, a written statement to that effect should be submitted. If an application is submitted, it must fully identify the bases for which information is claimed to be proprietary. The application should be prepared so that information sought to be withheld is incorporated in a separate paper and referenced in the application since the application will be placed in the Public Document Room. Your application, or written statement, should be submitted to us within 20 days. If we are not contacted as specified, the enclosed report and this letter may then be placed in the Public Document Room.

Should you have any questions concerning this letter, we will be glad to discuss them with you.

You should note that this letter and your reply to this letter will be disclosed to the public by being placed in an AEC Public Document Room.
