SURVEILLANCE REQUIREMENT - F20063H1

Enclosed for your information is a copy of a note from  
Tourtellotte to McDonough, dated May 6, 1975, relating to  
the subject interpretation. The legal staff does not agree  
with our long standing position regarding an effective date  
for starting the surveillance testing program. EL intends  
to advise DPC accordingly.

Based on the enclosed interpretation, we have initiated  
action to resolve the generic aspects of this problem. Our  
planned course of action is to recommend that the standard  
technical specifications be modified to establish a clear  
definition of time zero ( $t_0$ ) for the surveillance testing  
program.
