Dear Mr. O'Neill:

In response to your letter dated 10 January 1979, attached is an updated Final Cost Report. This report covers expenditures by CATALYTIC, INC. TMI - Unit #2 thru 31 December 1978. As agreed, quantities have not been updated.

By e on 31 January you requested that in addition to updating the information from our earlier report, we provide 1) average number of men per month (by craft) for each month during the period August '77 - August '78, and 2) man-hours per month (by craft) for the same period. CATALYTIC's accounting system at TMI accumulates data by craft for specific tasks and accounts, and summarizes by total job (includes Unit 1 and 2). In addition there is a daily Force Report reflecting how many of each craft for each TMI unit were brassed in on a given day. By manually averaging the Force Report data, item #1 above can be derived; two to three days dedicated effort for one person will be required. Item #2 will necessitate appreciable manual extraction and compilation; two to three weeks of dedicated effort will be required.

The personnel resources required for these tasks are not available without diversion from current higher priority work. I strongly recommend that you withdraw your request for these items.

If you determine that these report elements are required, it is requested that the effort be authorized by Mr. C. R. Montgomery.
