STAFF REQUIREMENTS - DISCUSSION OF SECY-78-109 A/B/C -- STANDARDIZATION OF NUCLEAR POWER PLANTS, 2:15 P.M., WEDNESDAY, JULY 5, 1978, COMMISSIONERS" CONFERENCE

The Commission discussed the proposed Statement on Standardization in the context of the related problem of reducing uncontrolled design changes. The Commission took no action, but noted that guidance on the proposed statement on standardization would be forthcoming. (SECY)

During the discussion of this matter, Chairman Hendrie and Commissioner Kennedy requested that their previous approval of this item be amended to include the following revised language in line 6, first full paragraph of p. 20 of the proposed policy statement, after the word "concept":

approved standard designs to those required for public health and safety. ...

In addition, the Chairman and Commissioner Kernedy commented that the staff should reexamine the format of the Regulatory Requirements Review Committee. (Subsequently, the Commission indicated that the staff further guidance on this matter would be forthcoming.) (OPE) (SECY Suspanse: 7/18/78)

Commissioner Gilinsky commented that the staff should be documenting criteria for a decision-making process to insure more explicit and defined control of changes, instead of using implicit undocumented criteria, based fundamentally on collective personal judgments. (NRR) (SECY Suspense: 9/30/78)
