- I. Comments from discussions with R. Zechman:
- A. TMI wants proposal for providing presentations on ICS for in-house training. G. Stoll has information on this matter.
 - B. Desires proposal for additional Phase V in March. Has been sent to Legal for review.
 - C. Rates for radiochemistry course not firm but will most likely be four straight weeks in February.
 - D. GPU is very interested in use of AUDI/POINTER training aid for in-house training. Recommend that G. Stoll investigate this item.

- E. Cave presentation to explain our requalification, replacement operator and long term program. NUS will be completing the requalification program requirements for Cyster Creek on December 17. TMI will be adapting this plan for their own and may incorporate parts of our program. This will be in January of 1974.
Many new TMI operators are being obtained from graduates with Associate Degrees from Penn State.
- G. Our PWR Technology course should not cover design material for future presentations to TMI.
- H. NUS is offering to provide training material for assisting in in-house NSSS system training. We stand to lose this business unless we make an effort to update our manuals.
- I. Important members of TMI staff will attend Nuclear Engineer course. Recommend that we place some extra effort in preparation for same.

- J. If we want to send our instructors to TMI we should send proposal stating what service they will provide. They do not have a schedule for licensing in late 1974 and I don't think we will make out better at TMI than Duke.
- II. Comments from discussions with Don E. Hetrick - GPU Operations
- A. Bid specification has been sent out for GPU training facility. Contract to be awarded in early 1974 for completion in early 1977. Will be located on Pennsylvania Turnpike about two driving hours from TMI. Center will consist of a EWR and a PWR simulator from TMI. A small staff will be utilized with most instruction being provided by site training coordinators. Annual expenses from 1977 to 1981 are estimated to be \$425,000.
- B. GPU needs Non-Operator training but cannot afford our price. Recommend that we add this service to our Long Term Package. They are interested in a 3-1/2 year contract and will contact us in early 1974.
- C. GPU is conducting a task analysis for maintenance training requirements in order to set up an in-house program. I feel that this will be a good market for self-training material but not for future instructor or classroom services.
- D. Operator losses at Peach Bottom have been 20-25% annually.
- E. GPU may want to use our replacement operator program even with their training center in operation.
