

The Washington Post of July 19, 1979, contained an article entitled. "Engineers Say Reactor Builder Ignored Warnings," (copy enclosed) in which it was reported that Joseph J. Kelly and Bert M. Dunn, Cabcock & Wilcox engineers, attempted to have BAN customers aferted to a transient which occurred at Davis-Besse Unit 1 on September 24, 1977. It has been alleged that this transfent is similar in many ways to the transfent at THI-2 on March 28, 1979. According to the Washington Post erticle, B&W supervisors refused to send customers the notification recommended by its engineers.
