Re Bynew - Reporting Requirements

I am informed that :

1. Part 21 became effective on August 10, 77. Position was that section 206 of the Energy Reorganization Act of 1974 was not self-implementing but required regulations. (Section 206 is the statutory basis for Part 21).

2. Vendor such as Westinghouse would have to report events under Part 21 if they ~~would~~ involve "defects or failures to comply which could create a substantial safety hazard in facilities and activities within the United States"

3. The only other [than Part 21] reporting requirement for such events might be through Appendix B to Part 50 (Q/A program imposed on vendors).

4. I am told that Bill Campbell (EO) & Bill Russell (NRC) want to be informed as to how Part 21 info, once received, is handled (input).
