Dear Sirs,

As a concerned citizen of Londonderry Township, I beg you to revoke Met-Ed's license for flagrant disregard of the safety of Londonderry citizens. (Need I remind you that TMI is located in Londonderry Township, Middletown, Pa.?)

The accident-not incident of March 28, 1979 should be enough in itself to cause you to revoke their license, but now they have chosen to dump radioactive water without testing in the Susquehanna River. I know that you will tell me that the amount of above substances dumped and released is within safety levels. But I am not satisfied with that answer. I can only reply by asking you to take similar amounts of arsenics--within safety levels--over the same period of time that we have absorbed strontium 90, iodine and krypton, and other radioactive materials.

I know that you would not like that anymore than I like the present situation under which I am living. You gentlemen of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission can be assured that we here in Londonderry Township are not going to tolerate this continued abuse by Metropolitan Edison Co. to our people, our animals and our land.

So we are asking you to take action at once. Start now by revoking this offensive company's license--namely Metropolitan Edison Company.
