

In the corrective action described for apparent noncompliance 10.B of the title letter, a commitment was made to conduct a review of certain exposure records by January 1980. A study of our files has shown that we had previously made the same commitment in letter GQL 1362, which addressed required licensee actions as a result of Investigative Report No. 50-320/79-10. This letter was dated October 29, 1979 and committed to complete the review by the end of January, 1980 and to have verified in NRC Form 5 by the end of February, 1980.

While we have been working toward this February completion date, the day to day workload in the area of health physics has become a full time job for our current staff. The review of records that we were planning to document by the end of February has slipped by some amount, which has not yet been determined. We are currently involved in on-site discussions with Joe Collins of the NRC aimed at arriving at a mutually acceptable date for both the NRC and the licensee. The tentative date we are discussing is April 30, 1980.
