I am strongly opposed to the plan to dump radioactive water into the Susquehanna River and to the planned releases of radioactive gases into the air. The results of March's accident's effect on pregnancies are not even known yet. How many chest x-rays and Rocky Mountain vacations are you planning to subject us to in the next few years? Is a month or two of krypton really equivalent to a month in the Rockies?

My mother's parents died of cancer. I knew a child who died from leukemia. They are very real diseases to me - not something that could never happen to me or my children.

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There are already so many carcinogens in our environment. Why must more be added - however dilute - when it is unnecessary?

If that water is dumped in the river, I'm leaving.
